



Professor Kriengsak Chareonwongsak is a Senior Fellow at Harvard University's Center for Business and Government, and an Associate at the Weatherhead Center for International Affairs, Harvard University. He is also a Visiting Fellow at the Oxford Internet Institute (OII), the University of Oxford. Professor Kriengsak was an elected Member of Parliament before the recent parliamentary dissolution and is currently on the Executive Board of the Democrat Party, in Thailand. He is President of the Institute of Future Studies for Development (IFD), Thailand. Professor Chareonwongsak obtained first class honors and a PhD in Economics from Monash University, Australia, 1981. He is also a graduate of Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University, with a Master's degree in Public Administration. He has held various university teaching positions. He has also filled fifty other positions in a number of national organizations and councils, including one constitutional body, the National Economic and Social Advisory Council (NESAC). In business, he is the Chairman of Success Group of Companies. Besides being the author of 150 books, Professor Chareonwongsak is a newspaper and magazine columnist and a regular radio and television talk show commentator discussing political issues of current concern. His perspectives are often highlighted in interviews both in Thailand and overseas.
